HAPA PAINTS A SMILE ON THE FACES OF CHILDREN WITH CANCER AT PPUM

This year, as HAPA successfully completes its first-ever Regional Series in 2008, the HAPA Committee is proud to announce that efforts to work directly to aid children with cancer, via Prof. Dr. Chan Lee Lee (Senior Consultant Paediatrician, Paediatric Haematology & Oncology, Head, Paediatric Haematopoietic Stem Cell Transplantation) and Pusat Perubatan Universiti Malaya, Kuala Lumpur also ended with smiles and applause. World Asia Publishing (WAP) had setup a 'HAPA Wish Tree' in the Paediatric Oncology Ward for the cancer children to have their wishes made known by writing down their 'ONE' wish and hanging them on the 'HAPA Wish Tree'. Proceeds and donations from this year's Gala Charity Dinner have been channelled primarily and exclusively to fulfilling these children's wishes. It is our hope that these simple grants, will improve their emotional environment and bring a spark of light to their quality of life – and a smile it did indeed paint on the faces of these children! Funds raised this year during the HAPA Awards Presentation and Gala Charity Dinner will be used to improve the Day Care Centre at the Children's Oncology Ward.

The Paediatric Oncology Ward at Pusat Perubatan Universiti Malaya, Kuala Lumpur receives up to 130 new patients a year and the ward currently has only 20 beds. Upon diagnosis, treatment is immediate and the lack of beds has caused a waiting period (days) for new patients. The ward tries to regulate patients to accommodate as many new patients as possible by using the Day Care Centre to facilitate 'healthier' patients.

While we cannot make their treatment less painful, we can certainly hope to make it more pleasant. World Asia Publishing and the children at the Paediatric Oncology Ward, Pusat Perubatan Universiti Malaya, Kuala Lumpur would like to thank everyone for their generosity and support.

Under the Hospitality Asia magazine, the HAPA is in its seventh year. Each year, we adopt a charity," said Jennifer Ong-Toh, 36, founder of World Asia Publishing, which publishes Hospitality Asia.

This year, they decided to set up the HAPA Wish Tree at the University Malaya Medical Centre (UMMC) paediatric ward and granted the wishes of 62 children.

Among the other items in the wish list were an electronic keyboard, a bicycle, laptops, DVD players and mobile phones.

Ranjetha Letchumanan, six, could not help admiring the new laptop that she received as she slowly ran her little hands across the shiny housing.

"She was always fascinated by laptops and she just wanted one so badly," said Ranjetha's mother Amuthadevi Suppiah, 38, from Shah Alam.

Ong-Toh said besides the wish tree, there would be a HAPA gala charity dinner on Nov 28 and all net proceeds from the dinner would be channelled towards a library and play area at the UMMC paediatric ward.

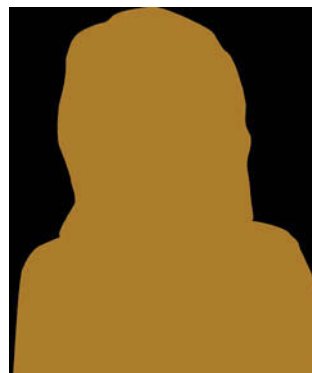

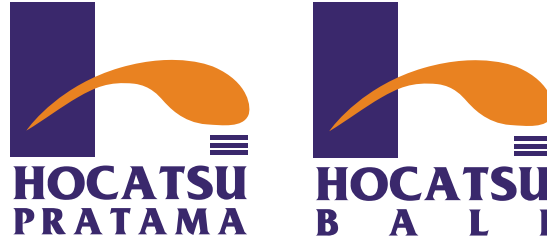

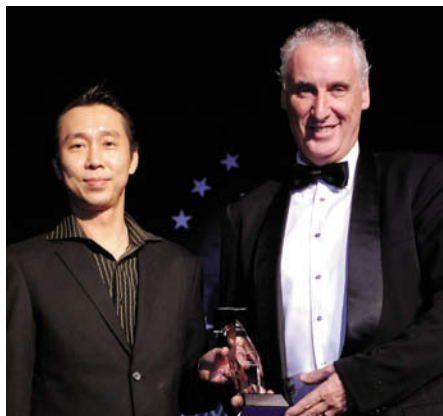

This is in the charming village of Chigny les Roses, near the city of Reims that the family CATTIER has been devoted to the culture of vineyards since 1763.

Present on prestigious tables in the world, the Clos du Moulin was also selected by Air France and British Airways to be served on board First Class and Concorde.

The CATTIER cellars are one of the deepest in Champagne. They have been dug on 3 levels and their vaults represent the 3 architecture styles : gothic, renaissance and roman.

The high quality of Champagnes CATTIER is regularly recognized by the international wine press. Let cite what the Parker Guide of French wines is writing :

- excellent in the category of the best Champagne producers
- among the best producers of non vintage Champagnes
- among the best Prestige Cuvees of Champagne with the Clos du Moulin

Besides the traditional cuvees, CATTIER launched since a few years a specific range of bottles, blending of elegance and modernity. This range is composed of a blue, a gold and now a red special shape bottle presented in a very innovative metal thread gift box.

This range has recently been completed by a quarter 200 ml with screw cap.
