

The Report Card

Location: Located on Jalan Tengah, it is just enough off the main Jalan Sultan Ismail thoroughfare to give a semblance of exclusive gated community living, but with all the lures of the central business district of Kuala Lumpur just a street away. Note, however that in view of the horrendous traffic situation at rush hour, walking to appointments or commuting by Light Rail Transport may be a better option than driving or hailing a cab.

Accommodation: Most possibly the most superior service suites in any class in Kuala Lumpur, E&O Residences Kuala Lumpur offers a choice of one (1131 sq ft) or two-bedroom (1442 sq ft) suites which echo its sister property, Eastern & Oriental Hotel Penang's his and her sinks and bathtub. Washing machine, dryer, microwave, oven, induction stove, pots, cutlery are all provided, along with generous storage space in the kitchen. Units also enjoy a home entertainment system, iPod docking station and wifi access, although the two-device cap per unit may handicap the multiple-device, constantly wired guest.

Food: The Residences are served by Delicious café, which offers all-day dining. Other restaurants, eating places and hawkers are just a street away.


Kid-friendly activities: The children's playroom is commendable and of the same calibre as some of Malaysia's best resort kids' clubs, with plush toys, crawl tunnels and indoor play equipment for a wide range of ages. Care is taken in the maintenance of the playroom and housekeeping staff are diligent about hygiene and orderliness. The outdoor playground is fun yet challenging, with slides and climbing vines which are located in an area paved with safety matting for soft falls.

Your Reviewer: Editor-in-Chief Karen-Michaela Tan travelled with her private secretary, photographer husband and fourand-a-half year old daughter and found the spaciousness of the two-bedroom living suite impressive. A whole day can be passed in the Residences, moving from breakfast at Delicious, to a swim in the infinity pool, a gym session and then meal preparation in the comprehensive kitchen. Alas, however, for the two device cap which hampers multiple users at the same time.

A tingle runs up one's spine driving up the lushly landscaped drive of Centara Grand Beach Resort & Villas Hua Hin. Pulling into the portico, the tingle develops into a whole body glow as you are greeted by legendary Thai hospitality, at a property which is just as legendary. Centara Grand Beach Resort is the oldest hotel in Hua Hin, the beach retreat of the Thai royal family for decades. Previously known as Sofitel Centara Grand Resort & Villas Hua Hin, the resort's new name, which came into effect in January 2012, reflects its continuing commitment towards excellent hospitality and a holiday experience bar none.

All Things Bright And Beautiful

he gorgeous property spills over with Old World charm, from luxurious rooms replete with fabulous bespoke bath amenities and Thai silk bed runners, Jacuzzis in the suites, and rooms which open up onto some lovely views. The sheer size of the resort would be overwhelming if not for the way it has been artfully carved out into different wings and sections, with pool areas serving individual wings and lovely walkways and manicured grounds which invite slow ambles and a heightened appreciation for topiary.

History buffs will love the fact that the 90-year-old resort is an essential part of the historical tapestry of Hua Hin, having opened in October 1922 and celebrated its grand opening on January 1 1923 as the Railway Hotel. Now a member of the Leading Hotels of the World, the property dates back to the time when Hua Hin itself was evolving into Thailand's first beach resort, due largely to the railway which was built from Bangkok to Malaysia. The railway accessibility meant the aristocrats were now able to move more speedily and comfortably to Hua Hin where they could take in the sea breeze and sun.

The traffic on the southern line to Malaysia warranted the building of a hotel which Royal Siamese Railways (RSR) commissioned Italian architect A Rigazzi to build. The Railway Hotel initially had only 14 guestrooms, but it was very well appointed and furnished and had an excellent standard of service to cater for its wealthy Thai and foreign guests.

By 1928 the hotel's reputation was international and in order to accommodate the growing number of visitors to Hua Hin, RSR added a new wing of 13 rooms, which were built to the exact same design as the existing building. After World War Two more guestrooms were added, along with three restaurants, a downstairs bar, and a lobby with a panoramic view of Hua Hin's glorious bay.

The value of the Railway Hotel as a building of architectural and historic interest was fully acknowledged by the Thai Government when in 1986 Central Group, the parent company of Centara Hotels & Resorts, acquired the property.

The much-loved historical building has been meticulously preserved, with all the subsequent additions being designed to blend perfectly with the existing structure and to maintain the air of elegance and leisure into which the hotel was born.

It is into this history that guests of this century are welcomed, and new love affairs with a 90-year-old doyenne continue to blossom. ha

The Report Card

Location: Hua Hin is a peaceful, idyllic seaside town, with enough nightlife to be exciting, but not so much that it becomes exhausting. It is a microcosm of the best of Thailand, and Centara Grand Beach Resort & Villas Hua Hin is the perfect location to savour it from. Centrally located near markets and retail areas, it is also a good jump-off point to the golf courses and vineyards which have made Hua Hin famous

Accommodation: The rooms are nothing short of excellent, designed to give an enveloping sense of comfort and welcome via the dark wood embellishments, muted lighting and luxurious bedding.
